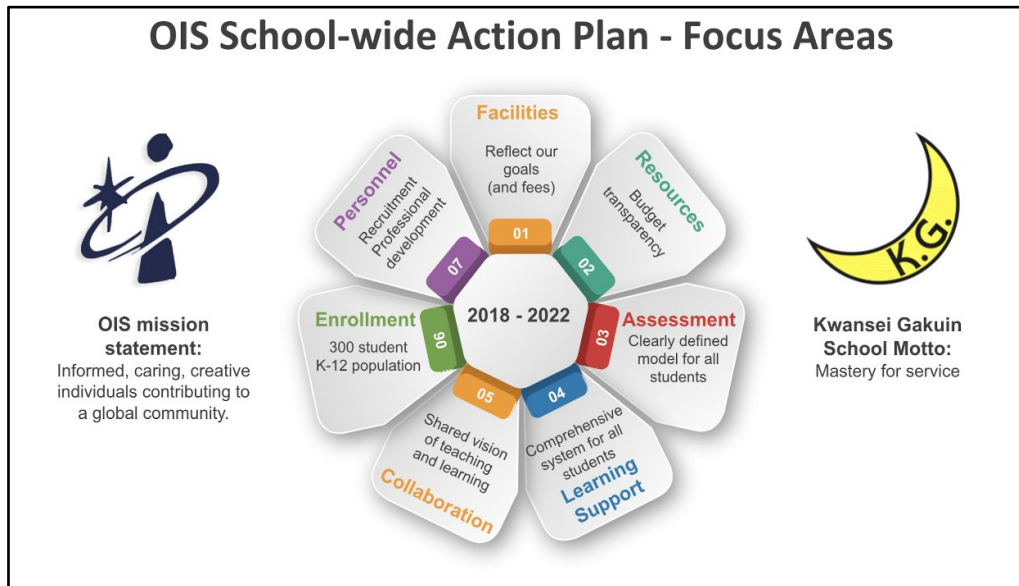
OIS has recently completed its WASC Mid-cycle Report and the WASC Mid-cycle Visit will take place on April 22-23. At the same time we are working on a new strategic plan for 2021-23 which will be shared with all stakeholders in May. It will incorporate feedback from the WASC visit.

OIS is also developing a strategy for introducing a child protection or safeguarding policy and other related measures, which include a code of conduct and disclosure/reporting procedures. This will improve the security of all students and reassure parents. All members of the community will be informed about it and all teachers and students in OIS will receive training about the new policy and what it means.

Enrollment looks stable for the next academic year and in August we do not anticipate any major reduction in numbers. We will produce a new brochure for our boarding programme and we will begin distributing and promoting from August 2021 with a view to students joining the programme for the August 2022 academic year.

The campus redevelopment project for this summer – library and genkan - will have a major impact on the appeal of the school and we hope that the ongoing schedule of upgrades, year on year will continue to make OIS a more attractive school for new customers as well as existing ones. OIS parents are generally very supportive and positive about the school, however they are also very keen to see the campus renovation plans move forwards this year. So we are optimistic that this project will generate a lot of good will and continued confidence in the school.
